already have the opportunity to share experiences and achieve sparring.



NEW STUDY COURSES IN PRINCIPLE THE ROAD TO PERSONAL MEDICINE



We have recently published a <u>new study</u> in which we analysed children and adolescents with the most common single gene cause of severe childhood obesity; MC4R. Various studies have shown that about 2-6% of children and adolescents with severe obesity may have a mutation in the MC4R gene.

The study showed that children and adolescents with severe obesity who had a mutation in the MC₄R gene were more difficult to treat with the Dr Holm model than other children and adolescents with severe obesity without an MC4R mutation. This in itself is not particularly surprising, as single gene causes most often lead to a more severe degree of overweight, which is traditionally also more difficult to treat. Over the past year, we have also been involved in publishing two other studies that are very relevant to this topic. In one study, we showed that parents of children and adolescents with severe obesity and MC4R mutation, who were also overweight / obese caused by an MC4R mutation, could be treated with a GLP-1 analogue, which in principle paves the way for personalized medicine. It should be understood that in principle we can now identify patients with MC4R mutations and then offer them treatment with a GLP-1 analogue. In that context, it is both relevant and exciting that Novo Nordisk is on its way with a study on GLP-1 treatment for adolescents aged 12-18 with



overweight / severe obesity. This suggests that in the future there will be medical opportunities for some of the children and young people with severe obesity who are difficult to treat with the Dr Holm model. The second study published in December 2018 showed that we were able to treat children and adolescents with overweight / severe obesity despite the fact that they had more or less strain of genes in a so-called genetic risk score consisting of the 15 genes known to cause obesity in children and adolescents. Together, the 3 studies show that it may be a good idea to perform genetic testing, and that some patients with mutations in the MC4R gene, for example, may benefit from medical treatment, but that other children and adolescents with severe obesity with other mutations in other genes can actually be treated with advantage with the Dr Holm model.
