





We hope you all have a good summer and come back with renewed energy, which will surely become important when we all must help children, young people, and adults after the covid-19 pandemic shutdown.

We will probably have a busy autumn. For example, in the pediatric ward, we will start a large number of children and adolescents with obesity in GLP-1 treatment. In the last couple of years, we have made records of patients who could be relevant candidates for this type of medical treatment. We are in the process of a GLP-1 study in adults (over 18 years) with less than expected effect of treatment with the Dr Holm obesity management model. Either they receive GLP-1 or placebo in a controlled design, to evaluate whether treatment with GLP-1 can help patients who have otherwise been more difficult to treat. We are also sponsoring another study where we will treat adolescents with severe obesity and psychiatric issues with GLP-1 or placebo to find out if we can help this group better than today. All the above-mentioned treatments and studies are supported by the Dr Holm model, which is supported with the Obesity Treatment Tool Pro.

NEW POLYCYSTIC OVARY SYNDROME (PCOS) STUDY

In a collaboration with Bispebjerg and Frederiksberg Hospitals (Center for Clinical Research and Prevention) 65,665 girls from 'the



Copenhagen School Health Records Register', who were born in the period 1960-1996, with information about birth weight and measured height and weight at both 7- and 13-year-olds were included. 606 women aged 15-50 years were identified with PCOS. Birth weight was not associated with the development of polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS), but girls with overweight identified at 7–13 years of age had a higher risk of PCOS than girls without overweight. In addition, girls with overweight at both 7- and 13- years of age had a higher risk of PCOS than girls who exhibited overweight at only one of the measurements at 7 or 13 years of age. High height was also associated with the development of PCOS at all ages. The study thus concluded that higher degrees of overweight and height showed a correlation with the risk of developing PCOS. MASTERCLASS FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS



At the MasterClass on 28 May 2021, two cases were reviewed. Both cases involved children of approx. 11-13 years who, despite treatment, still had a high BMI. At least this is what it looked like at first glance, but both cases were characterized by the patients following the treatment plan quite well, which is why the therapists asked how to assess the treatment effort. However, a closer look at the bioimpedance measurements and the development of the distribution of fat and muscle, it became clear that both children had had a very positive development, both by increasing their muscle mass and at the same time reducing their fat mass. So even though they both had a



high BMI through the treatment, it was with a favorable development in the body composition and thus with an increased degree of health as a result.

Thus, it could be assessed that the treatment worked as intended and that the risk of developing obesity-related complications was thus also reduced. This is a good and important reminder to always look individually at each patient and gain certainty about how the muscle and fat distribution in the body develops through the treatment.
